2015 Jan. 1 —Statutes take effect (Art. IV, Sec. 8(c)).

Jan. 4 —Legislature reconvenes (J.R. 51(a)(1)).

Jan. 8 —Budget must be submitted by Governor (Art. IV, Sec. 12(a)).

Jan. 18 —Martin Luther King, Jr. Day.

Jan. 29 —Last day to submit bill requests to the Office of Legislative Counsel.

Feb. 15 —Presidents' Day.

Feb. 26 —Last day for bills to be introduced (J.R. 61(a)(1)), (J.R. 54(a)).

Mar. 27 —Spring Recess begins at end of this day's session (J.R. 51(a)(2)).

Mar. 31 —Cesar Chavez Day.

Apr. 4 —Legislature reconvenes from Spring Recess (J.R. 51(a)(2)).

April 29 —Last day for policy committees to hear and report to Fiscal Committees fiscal bills introduced in their house (J.R. 61(a)(2)).

May 15 —Last day for policy committees to hear and report to the Floor non-fiscal bills introduced in their house (J.R. 61(a)(3)).

May 22 —Last day for policy committees to meet prior to June 8 (J.R. 61(a)(4)).

May 25 —Memorial Day.

May 29 —Last day for fiscal committees to hear and report to the Floor bills introduced in their house (J.R. 61(a)(5)). Last day for fiscal committees to meet prior to June 8 (J.R. 61(a)(6)).

May 30 – June 3 —Floor Session Only. No committee may meet for any purpose (J.R. 61(a)(7)).

June 3 —Last day for bills to be passed out of the house of origin (J.R. 61(a)(8)). June 8 —Committee meetings may resume (J.R. 61(a)(9)).

June 15 —Budget must be passed by midnight (Art. IV, Sec. 12 (c)(3)).

July 4 —Independence Day.

July 15 —Last day for policy committees to meet and report bills (J.R. 61(a)(10)). Summer Recess begins at the end of this day's session, provided the Budget has been enacted (J.R. 51(a)(3)).

Aug. 15 —Legislature reconvenes from Summer Recess (J.R. 51(a)(3)).

Aug. 26 —Last day for fiscal committees to meet and report bills to the Floor (J.R. 61(a)(11)).

Aug. 29–Sep.9—Floor Session only. No committees, other than Conference Committees and Rules Committee, may meet for any purpose (J.R. 61(a)(12)).

Sep. 2 —Last day to amend bills on the Floor (J.R. 61(a)(13)).

Sep. 5 —Labor Day.

Sep. 9 —Last day for each house to pass bills (J.R. 61(a)(14)). Interim Study Recess begins at the end of this day's session (J.R. 51(a)(4)).

Oct. 7 —Last day for Governor to sign or veto bills passed by the Legislature on or before Sep. 11 and in the Governor's session after Sep. 11 (Art. IV, Sec. 10(b)(1))

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
