STANDARD DEDUCTION \$112

- 1. Subtract the Standard Deduction from the Gross Income
- 2. Divide the remainder by one half
- 3. Subtract that number from the MAP or EMAP
- 4. The difference will be the CalWORKs benefit amount

Who Is Eligible for CHILD CARE?

- 1. Persons who are getting CalWORKs money <u>and</u> working or participating in any WtW activity and need child care for children 12 unless the child is disabled.
- 2. Persons who used to get CalWORKs money in the past 2 years if their gross income is below 70% of the State median income (SMI) and need child care.
- 3. Persons who used to get CalWORKs money longer than 2 years ago if their gross income is below the 70% of the SMI, <u>and</u> they need child care, and if child care money is available
