## CalWORKs Property Limits

**\$3,500** liquid resources for households with member(s) over 60 and **\$2,250** for all other households.

**\$9,500** for a motor vehicle TOTALLY EXEMPT if used for work, as a home, for fishing or was a gift.

# How to Count CalWORKs Earned Income

- 1 Substracy the Standard Deduction of \$225 from the gross inocme
- 2. Divide the remainder by one half:
- 3. Subtract that number from the MAP or EMAP of the family size;
- 4. The difference will be the CalWORKs benefit amount.

Who Is Eligible for CalWORKS CHILD CARE?

- 1. Persons who are getting CalWORKs money <u>and</u> working or participating in any WtW activity and need child care for children 12 years of age unless the child is disabled.
- 2. Persons who used to get CalWORKs money in the past 2 years if their gross income is below 75% of the State median income (SMI) and need child care.
- 3. Persons who used to get CalWORKs money longer than 2 years ago if their gross income is below the 75% of the SMI, <u>and</u> they need child care, and if child care money is available.
